MINUTES of **the Council Meetings**

Actions or Decisions taken by the Council:

- ☞ The Council has taken all necessary measures, technical and organisational, to protect the information it has on individuals in accordance with the rules of RGPD currently in place,
- ☞ Roseline GUEZET retired on 1 October 2018,
- ☞ The annual reports on the price and quality of drinking water and sewage were presented to the Council and are available at the Mairie.
- ☞ To remain under the guidance of VGA on the use of land in accordance with its decree of 22 November 2018.
- ☞ The Council decided on 30 January 2019 not to exercise its right of pre-emption over the woods at La Foret.
- ☞ The Annual General Meeting of Souvenir Francais noted the donation given on 9 March 2019 pour the restoration of the war memorial,
- ☞ Madame Nadia Le Houarner was nominated as delegate for the Electoral Roll,
- ☞ Le The Council decided to take part in the in the market to purchase electricity proposed by SDEE 47.
- ☞ The Council decided on 24 January 2020 to exercise its right of pre-emption on the land owned by DaRos to buy the land adjoining the new covered hall,
- ☞ Upkeep of the lanes cost:
 - Lane no 11 by Colas Billaud: 1192.50 before tax 1431.00 inc tax
 - Lane by Jean Michaud: 616.50 before tax 739.80 inc tax.
 - Lane no 10 by Menuisier: 2001.00 before tax 2401.20 inc tax.
 - Lane by Jacques Pont: 808.50 before tax 970.20 inc tax
- ☞ It was agreed to let the vacant land by Charlot to Parc Griffon for a year to increase the parking there.
- ☞ The Council decided :
 - To require notification before the installation of a fence,
 - To require notification before the demolition of all or part of a building,
 - To apply this throughout the commune.
- ☞ A gift note of 15 euros was given to each child under 12 for Christmas,
- ☞ On 13 March 2020, an exchange of land between the commune and Mr Christian COUZIGOU was agreed to facilitate the creation of a road.
- ☞ The Council agreed the following grants, totalling 2300 euros.
 - ASSAD at Levignac 200 euros
 - Entertainment Committee 1000 euros
 - The hunt Saint Hubert of Caubon Saint Sauveur 600 euros
 - The school at Castelnau sur Gupie 500 euros

Actions or Decisions taken by the Council- continued


- ☞ The level of local taxes was not increased for 2019 or 2020 :
 - Taxe d'habitation 8.93
 - Taxe fonciere on building land 12.68
 - Taxe fonciere on non building land 52.91

 - ☞ The accounts for 2018 and 2019 were approved unanimously.

 - ☞ Summary of the accounts for 2019:
 - Operational : Expenses 112,016 Receipts 399,998
 - Investment : Expenses 13,920 Receipts 277,226

 - ☞ The Council renounced its right over the sale of the woods belonging to M and Mme LATASTE,

 - ☞ Following a public enquiry, it was agreed that the owners of land bordering the rural lanes of Les Aubinettes, Caubon West, Paillet and Lapetit could purchase it for 2 euros a square metre.

 - ☞ Works on the construction of a new covered hall:
 - The Council has pursued all the grants available (from VGA, the department, fines received by the Police and DETR 2019).
 - Andre NOWAK was chosen as the architect.
 - The Council is now awaiting tenders.

- ☞ It was agreed to increase the allowance paid to the two wardens of the two churches, Pierrette DAL BELLO and Roseline SOUNALET.

 - ☞ The council reconfirmed its agreement to VGA regarding the use of soil.

 - ☞ Election of representatives to Val De Garonne Agglomeration
 - ✓ Francis LATRILLE (first) and Eric DELMOTTE (deputy) for the waterways of the Trec, Gupie and Medier SMATGM (GEMAP)

Jérôme DAL BELLO ?

Jerome DAL BELLO has lived in our village since he was born 39 years ago and lives at Aux Arnaux with Helene and their three children, Louis, Aaron and Joyce.

He represents the third generation of Dal Bellos in our village. He likes especially the quality of life, the quiet and the countryside.

He wanted to be a fireman but having found himself in the bosom of a family of stone masons from a young age, he decided to carry on the family tradition.

Jerome gained his experience with lots of companies in the area and then he joined his father and became manager in 2004 of the company SARL DB Maçonnerie. This company was created by his grandfather and has always been in Caubon.



Armed with a CAP/BEP Maçonnerie and a BAC pro Etude de prix et Gestion de chantier, he worked with his father for 12 years.

The company, composed of Jerome and a workman, specialises in all types of building- roofing- tiling-plaster boarding. They undertake renovation or new builds within a radius of 20 kms.

++++ : the ability to build his own house and other work at his place, being able to work without having to worry about bad weather.



---- : Minuses-paper work, and difficulty trying to find skilled workers to work in the company.

His aims: continue the business and find a third person.
